

Supporting Those Affected by Hurricane Michael

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As operations resume in areas impacted by Hurricane Michael, American Airlines is ramping up efforts to support those impacted in the communities it serves.

Later this month, 200 Miami-based team members will pack 5,000 hygiene comfort kits with soap, deodorant, towels, toothbrushes, toothpaste and more to be distributed by the **American Red Cross** to those most impacted by Hurricane Michael. Early next month, more than 200 team members in Chicago will partner with **Feeding America** to assemble 75,000 pounds of food for food banks in the areas impacted by recent natural disasters.

Late last month more than 170 team members descended on the Charlotte Douglas International Airport Line Maintenance hangar to help those impacted by Hurricane Florence. Team members spent the day packing 75,000 pounds of food into 5,000 emergency food kits, to be distributed to individuals affected by recent natural disasters. American partnered with Feeding America, a national non-profit organization who works with local food banks to connect people with food in times of need. Second Harvest Food Bank of Metrolina was the recipient of all 5,000

kits. They then transported all the meals to Fayetteville, Charleston, Myrtle Beach and other coastal Carolina cities.
