## Whirlpool Corporation to Present at the Energy Efficiency Global Forum 2014

Industry thought leaders will discuss how predicted changes in the energy landscape may impact their ability to produce, sell and innovate energy-efficient products and services.
- Nathan Mouw will participate in an executive dialogue session on Wednesday, May 21, from 1:45-3:00 p.m. EDT. His session will address, "How do advances in technology affect possibilities for EE standards and harmonization?".
- Ron Voglewede will be part of the executive dialogue session also on Wednesday, May 21, from 1:45-3:00 p.m. EDT. The session will discuss, "Amidst aging infrastructure and a changing environment, how are facilities taking steps to become independent from the grid?".
