# 1.0 INTRODUCTION

This Summary of the May 2013 Open Houses is part of the commitment of the IAMGOLD Corporation (IAMGOLD) to inform and consult with local communities and stakeholders regarding the proposed Côté Gold Project. The Open Houses were organized by IAMGOLD to provide information about the Project and to review and seek feedback on the Draft Terms of Reference (ToR) under the Provincial Individual Environmental Assessment. This Report presents a summary of the consultation activities and feedback associated with these sessions.

# 2.0 CONSULTATION PROCESS

# 2.1 Notification of the Open Houses

Notifications of the Open Houses were provided in advance to all households in the communities of Gogama, West Tree and Shining Tree as well as the Mattagami First Nation Reserve through the Gogama Local Service Board. Notices were also mailed to all individuals on the Project Mailing List.

Notices were published in local newspapers as summarized in Table 1. Copies of the newspaper advertisements are presented in Appendix A.

Attendees were encouraged to sign a register at the door and indicate whether they would want to be placed on the Project Mailing List. A summary of the attendance at each session is presented in Table 3.

#### 2.4 Additional Avenues for Comments

# 3.0 CONCLUSION

Overall, there was a positive interest in the Project as a socio-economic benefit to the area. From the comments received, concerns were raised with respect to:

- Potential loss of the Circle M Canoe Route; and
- Proposed locations of the Tailings Management Facility, mine rock piles, and points of water take and (effluent) discharge.



### The Process:



It sets out the framework and work plan for addressing the Environmental Assessment Act requirements when preparing the environmental assessment, including such things as the alternatives that will be considered, how environmental effects will evaluated, and the proposed public consultation activities.

A final proposed Terms of Reference will be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment (the Ministry) and will be issued for a formal comment period coordinated by the Ministry. This document will consider comments received on the draft Terms of Reference. If approved by the Minister, the proposed Terms of Reference will provide the framework and requirements for the preparation of the environmental assessment.



If you are saving for retirement and find that you are glued to the radio or TV when the stock market is experiencing wild and volatile move-ments, you may find yourself asking "why am I taking a risk by investing and not just saving

in a bank account or a GIC?"

It is at times like 2001 and 2009 when we saw huge shifts of capital move from the stock market to the safety of GIC's that cement our understanding that fear of losing far outweighs

our desire to gain.

The reason we invest is because we know we have to save for retirement and, in many cases, we need a decent return on our savings to achieve our goals. There were times when interest rates were so high that we could easily reach our targets with a GIC or savings account, but the days of double-digit interest rates are far behind us and they may not return for the foreseeable future.

Right now, you are lucky to get a savings rate of about to get a savings rate of about 1.65%, and locking your money up for five years in a GIC can get you about 2.5% per year. These historically low rates really hit home when you go on the Bank of Canada website and see that they aim to keep inflation between 1% and 3%.

Let's face it, \$50,000 a year today is not what it used to be and, in the future, it won't be what it is today. According to the "Rule of 72" a 3% inflation rate means that your costs of living will double every 24 years

(72 divided by 3 is 24). With 3% inflation, \$50,000

Rising food prices are making Canadians cut back on other expenses and contributing to a generally negative outlook on the economy, an RBC study has found

Consumers are feeling the "food inflation" of the past few years, which saw an increase of 2.4% last year following increases of 3.8% and 1.4% in 2011 and 2010, respectively, RBC said. It also predicts last year's drought conditions in the U.S. could send food prices up another 3-4% this year.


