OVERVIEW

Flamingo Las Vegas is located on the famous intersection of Las Vegas Boulevard and Flamingo Road within walking distance of many resorts and attractions, including The LINQ Hotel + Experience, The LINQ Promenade featuring the High Roller Observation Wheel and Fly LINQ Zipline, Caesars Palace, The Cromwell (soon to be The Vanderpump Hotel) and Horseshoe Las Vegas. Bugsy Siegel's desert dream, Flamingo Las Vegas, has anchored the Las Vegas Strip since the destination started rolling dice in 1946. This iconic resort offers a variety of dining and entertainment options, as well as a Wildlife Habitat and a 15-acre, Caribbean-style pool.

CASINO

With more than 93,000 square feet of casino space, the Flamingo caters to every player on every level, featuring more than 870 slot machines and more than 55 table games. Sports enthusiasts can relax in a comfortable, oversized chair at the **Caesars Race & Sportsbook at Flamingo**, featuring large-screen TVs and no-limit pari-mutuel wagering. Thoroughbred racing from New York is available daily with some of the highest payoffs in Nevada.

MEETING SPACE

Flamingo's 73,000-square-foot Corporate Convention Center and Executive Conference Center offer exceptional flexibility to accommodate large or small meetings in style. Convenient and inviting seating areas outside many of the meeting rooms are perfect for pre-function conversation or meeting breaks. The Flamingo features dozens of versatile spaces ranging from 500 to more than 20,000 square feet.

GUEST ROOMS

3,460 total guest rooms, including 3,288 standard rooms and 172 suites

Flamingo Las Vegas has invested \$156 million to date for hotel room renovations. The resort completed an initial \$90 million redesign of 1,270 guest rooms and suites, followed by the completion of a 976-room renovation in

December 2018. Two-thirds of the room product at Flamingo Las Vegas has been renovated in recent years.

Designed by Forrest Perkins, the latest Flamingo Las Vegas rooms feature contemporary, retro-chic designs that celebrate the resort's rich history, with vibrant hues of gold and bright pops of flamingo pink.

Bunk Bed Rooms and Suites

Flamingo Las Vegas debuted 14 Bunk Bed Rooms in February 2019, along with one of the largest dedicated Bunk Bed Suites in the U.S., as part of the second phase of the resort's room renovation.

Ideal for entertaining large families or groups with nearly 1,000 square feet of space, the upscale **Bunk Bed Suite** at Flamingo Las Vegas consists of a 430-square-foot bedroom with two queen beds, each equipped with its own overhead full-size bunk, connected to a 550-square-foot parlor that includes a living area with oversized lounge furniture and a full kitchenette with a refrigerator.

The 515-square-foot **Bunk Bed Room** can accommodate a group of friends or the whole family with two queen beds, each equipped with its own overhead full-size bunk. The upgraded room also features modern décor paired with sleek furnishings, a sofa, bedside USB ports, a 55-inch HDTV, a separate vanity area, and a rain shower in a stylish bathroom. In addition to the generous sleeping space, the hotel's center-Strip location and classic Vegas feel brings more allure to this room.

RuPaul's Drag Race LIVE!

Some of the most famous drag queens in the world are taking over the Las Vegas Strip when *RuPaul's Drag Race Live!* hits the stage at Flamingo Las Vegas. Each live performance is packed with outrageous comedy, eye-popping fashions, over-the-top singing and dancing, heartwarming moments, plus twists and turns that will leave the audience gagging for more. The atmosphere of the show is interactive and encourages audience members' participation, as if they were attending a live episode of the world-famous competition. Seven queens will be featured in each show from a rotating cast of Drag Race favorites.

Piff the Magic Dragon

Piff and Mr. Piffles, the World's Only Magic Performing Chihuahua, perform a selection of their greatest hits from a repertoire that stretches over six previous critically acclaimed solo shows, with each routine featuring their signature approach to conjuring that puts a new twist on the traditional magic show.

Bugsy's Cabaret

X Burlesque

The steamiest show on the Strip, X Burlesque showcases a variety of performances by six gorgeous dancers set to music by today's hottest artists. Some new additions include a feisty Latin number, a Country-Western medley set to Jessica Simpson's "Boots" and Toby Keith's "She's a Hottie" and a sexy performance to Aerosmith's "Pink." For 90 minutes, the burlesque beauties bare

their assets all while teasing, seducing and playfully interacting with the audience.

Wayne: Up Close and Personal

The legendary Wayne Newton presents a limited engagement of “Wayne: Up Close and Personal” inside Bugsy’s Cabaret. Having achieved “headliner” status for the first time in his career at Flamingo in the 1960s, Mr. Las Vegas makes a triumphant return to the iconic resort. “Wayne: Up Close and Personal” presents the entertainer in an intimate setting where he will interact with the audience, perform some favorite songs and share personal career highlights through songs, film clips, anecdotes and audience Q&A.

Bugsy’s Bar

Bugsy’s Bar is open 24 hours in the center of the casino, at the heart of all the action. Guests may test their luck and skill on popular video poker games and enjoy one of the drink specials at this action-packed Flamingo Las Vegas bar.

The Count Room

The Count Room is a prohibition era-inspired speakeasy in the back of Bugsy & Meyer’s Steakhouse. Guests can enjoy cocktails and light bites in the speakeasy daily, along with live entertainment on Friday and Saturday nights.

RESTAURANTS

Gordon Ramsay Burger at Flamingo Las Vegas

World-famous chef and television personality Gordon Ramsay has welcomed his seventh Las Vegas restaurant with Caesars Entertainment, **Gordon Ramsay Burger** at Flamingo Las Vegas. The restaurant's debut follows the success of the first Gordon Ramsay Burger, which opened at Planet Hollywood Resort & Casino in December 2012. Signature menu items exclusively available at the Flamingo location include the Cluck Yeah G.F.C. (Gordon’s Fried Chicken) Sandwich, Full English Breakfast Burger and Benedict Burger. Guests can also enjoy the new signature Pink Drink that is served in a flamingo coupe or The Bloody Blonde cocktail. Those with a sweet tooth can choose from a variety of milkshakes and desserts. The 12,000-square-foot space features a large exhibition kitchen, island-style bar as the restaurant’s social hub, expansive storefront windows, multiple dining zones, a nod to Britannia with Union Jack accents and dynamic flame displays. The 50-seat, open-air patio overlooks the bustling Las Vegas Strip and is anchored by a 25-foot-tall LED column showcasing Gordon Ramsay Burger imagery underneath the famous Flamingo neon.

Pinky’s by Vanderpump

Following the success of Vanderpump à Paris at Paris Las Vegas and Vanderpump Cocktail Garden at Caesars Palace, the restaurateur, television star and philanthropist has opened her third venue on The Strip, **Pinky’s by Vanderpump** at Flamingo Las Vegas. With a nod to the Flamingo’s vibrant history, the 198-seat restaurant and bar (coined after Vanderpump’s nickname, “Pinky”) combines Art Deco glamour with lavish and decadent Vanderpump flair. Spanning nearly 7,000 square feet and set against a palette of muted greens, brass accents and blush pink, the space boasts a dramatic 32-seat bar and a covered terrace right on the Las Vegas Strip. The signature Vanderpump extravagance also translates to the cocktail and food menu, with playful nods to the vintage theme and some seriously Instagrammable moments. Menu

highlights include the Pump & Bump caviar martini, Deviled Egg Gardens with decadent toppings and Wagyu Slides with roasted shishito peppers and dill pickle tater tots.

Havana 1957

Las Vegas visitors and locals can enjoy a Cuban American affair as Miami's iconic Havana 1957 and Cortadito Coffee House from Vida & Estilo Hospitality Group come to Flamingo Las Vegas this winter. Transporting guests to the glory of Havana in the glamorous 1950s, Havana 1957 is a celebration of Cuban classics, from breakfast bites to mojito nights. Offering breakfast, lunch, dinner, and late-night fare, the new restaurant celebrates the brand's journey from Cuba to Miami, and now Las Vegas. Havana 1957's menu takes diners on a tour of Cuban flavors, marrying traditional dishes like Ropa Vieja and Croquetas with Miami inspirations like Cuban Sandwiches and a signature Cuban Burger. Las Vegas' unique menu will also include classic American breakfast favorites with Cuban flair, making Havana 1957. The restaurant is joined by South Florida's favorite Cuban American coffee house, Cortadito. The perfect stop for classic cortadito, café con leche, or latte, the coffee house combines classic coffee favorites with Cuban specialties.

Bugsy & Meyer's Steakhouse

Bugsy & Meyer's Steakhouse transports guests back to the resort's vintage roots while serving a fresh and intriguing steakhouse experience in a modern way. The restaurant's name is a nod to Benjamin "Bugsy" Siegel and business partner Meyer Lansky, who famously opened the Flamingo Las Vegas back in 1946 to bring Hollywood glam to the desert. From menu, design and atmosphere, Bugsy & Meyer's Steakhouse takes notes from the past and adds modern twists. The restaurant features a bakery façade, dry-aged meat cooler, centerpiece bar and lounge, raw bar, three private dining rooms, an ornate dining room, a hidden speakeasy – The Count Room and more. Bugsy & Meyer's in-house dry-aged program is showcased in the restaurant in a glass-encased show cooler. Hand-selected cuts include domestic prime, wet-aged, dry-aged prime, imported wagyu and more.

Carlos 'n Charlie's

Carlos 'n Charlie's is the Mexican restaurant to get loose and have more than just a dining experience. Guests unwind and dance to the tunes of '70s, '80s and current hits of today. Partygoers can enjoy the extensive bar menu featuring margaritas, sangria and a lengthy selection of signature cocktails, including the signature Paloma. The food menu offers a wide variety of authentic Mexican favorites, including tableside guacamole.

WEDDINGS

Set amidst the 15-acre tropical oasis, Flamingo offers five unique wedding chapels and gardens, with seating for up to 80 guests.

The Garden Chapel, nestled on the highest hilltop of Flamingo's lush tropical retreat, features a graceful arched ceiling, elegant columns, crystal pillars, splashes of floral and four pearlescent upholstered pews with modern flooring. This timeless indoor venue can seat up to 60 guests.

The Gazebo Chapel is the perfect setting for an enchanted, romantic garden ceremony. The ivy-covered gazebo is surrounded by towering palm trees and accented by colorful garden flowers. The gazebo is comfortably nestled behind the Garden Chapel to create a secluded and private ceremony. This venue can seat up to 80 guests.

Paradise Falls is the ideal venue for a small, intimate ceremony. The cascading waterfalls and peaceful pond create a scenic, naturally beautiful location for 15 or fewer guests (standing room only).

The West Lawn is surrounded by a variety of trees, lush greenery and fresh flowers, with a lovely, white gazebo as the centerpiece of this perfect ceremony backdrop. The West Lawn can seat up to 80 guests.

The Crescendo Pool offers a beautifully lit waterfall and grand entrance for a memorable ceremony. The couple will say “I do” on an elevated area of the pool. The venue can seat up to 60 guests.

WILDLIFE HABITAT Spanning four acres, the Flamingo Wildlife Habitat is an all-ages attraction that is free and open daily. Namesake Chilean Flamingos – along with a wide variety of rescued animals, including multiple species of exotic waterfowl, brown pelicans, turtles, fish and hummingbirds – are carefully tended by experts and live on islands and streams surrounded by sparkling waterfalls and lush foliage. Guests can enjoy daily keeper talk presentations at 8:30 a.m. and 2 p.m. The Flamingo Wildlife Habitat is a Certified Wildlife Habitat by the National Wildlife Association.

POOLS Las Vegas’ favorite tropical oasis has entered a new era just in time for pool season. A \$20 million project, the all-new GO Pool at the iconic Flamingo Las Vegas will feature a multi-pool complex with a 30-seat swim-up bar. Spanning nearly 1.5 acres, the GO Pool complex will offer five distinct pools and experiences at varying levels throughout the space. Additional highlights include temperature-controlled pools, 33 VIP cabanas with elegant furnishings, cool-deck surfacing, night lighting and a robust sound system. The reimagined GO Pool menu will feature refreshing beverage offerings, from sharable cocktails to summertime staples like frozen daquiris and signature mojitos. Guests can also enjoy delicious poolside bites from the full kitchen. The Family Pool offers an environment where guests of all ages can soak up the Las Vegas sun and enjoy views of the lush habitat.

SPA Conveniently located along Flamingo’s shopping promenade, the redesigned Spa at Flamingo Las Vegas transports guests to a relaxing tropical oasis. The separate men’s and women’s spa facilities include three pools set at different temperatures, a sauna, a eucalyptus steam room and a relaxation lounge with healthy snacks. The Spa at Flamingo also features a 2,400-square-foot fitness center.

MONORAIL Flamingo offers convenient access to the Las Vegas Monorail. The station is located past the Flamingo lobby toward the parking garage.
