Built on the belief that glassware and presentation should elevate, not distract from, the drink itself, the Barcelona bar combines innovative technique and familiar flavors to deliver memorable cocktails.

The **Purple Rain**, an elegant, modern take on a whiskey sour, features bourbon mellowed with wild sour honey and beetroot. For a refreshing option, the **Mosaic** combines pisco brandy with aromatic woods from the Amazon rainforest and is served in a painted glass reminiscent of Barcelona's modernist art movement.
