OVERVIEW

Caesars Palace spans 85 acres at the heart of the Las Vegas Strip, just 10 minutes from McCarran International Airport. Caesars Palace offers a total of 3,980 rooms, including more than 300 suites, throughout five hotel towers (not including Nobu Hotel):

- **Julius Tower** (formerly the original Roman Tower) – 587 rooms and suites; opened in 1966 and renovated in 2015
- **Palace Tower** – 1,181 rooms and suites, including 10 luxurious new villas on the 29th floor; opened in 1997, refreshed in 2006 and renovated in 2017
- **Augustus Tower** – 952 rooms and suites, including three luxury villas; opened in 2005 and refreshed in 2016
- **Octavius Tower** – 668 rooms and suites, including six luxury villas; opened in 2012
- **Forum Tower** – 452 rooms and suites, including two villas; renamed from Olympic Tower in 1997 and renovated in 2008
- **Nobu Hotel** (formerly Centurion Tower) – 182 rooms, including 18 suites and one villa; opened in 2013 and refreshed in 2021

In September 2022, Caesars Palace completed a **multimillion-dollar renovation of the original main entrance, iconic casino dome and porte-cochère**. The redesigned space includes a dramatic entryway with a coffered ceiling, refreshed gaming areas and the new Galleria Bar in the hotel lobby. After raising the roof of the entryway to match the grandeur of the hotel lobby, guests arriving at Caesars Palace now enter a beautifully lit space, with a coffered ceiling and an intricate marble mosaic floor. A 15-foot-tall Carrara marble statue of Augustus Caesar welcomes visitors under the raised ceiling, which features hand-painted illustrations of Roman gods and a spectacular chandelier containing 70,000 crystals.

TOWERS

In December 2021, **Nobu Hotel Caesars Palace** completed a multimillion-dollar refresh of all 182 guest rooms and public areas. To create a more modern, residential feel, the award-winning global architecture and design firm Rockwell Group re-envisioned the guest rooms and common areas it first designed in 2013. Rockwell Group drew inspiration from kintsugi, the Japanese art of repairing broken pottery with gold epoxy – creating cohesion from collage. This element creates a streamlined, lighter and more luxe take on the original design concept.

In 2017, Caesars Palace completed a renovation of its **Palace Tower**, the resort's largest tower, featuring 1,181 stylishly designed guest rooms and suites and a price tag topping \$100 million. Considered the crown jewel of the tower, the coveted 29th floor features 10 luxurious villas ranging in size from 2,750 to 4,085 square feet and featuring exquisite finishes, bespoke furnishings and a curated art program. The Palace Tower's elegantly designed guest rooms and suites feature cool grey tones accented by royal blue and champagne gold. Centrally located, the Palace Tower is a short walk to the resort's convention center, Appian Way shops and Garden of the Gods Pool Oasis.

During the resort's 50th anniversary celebration in 2016, Caesars Palace reimagined its original hotel tower, the Roman Tower, and transformed it into the **Julius Tower**. The \$75 million hotel tower renovation was part of a \$1 billion investment into the resort. With 587 rooms, the Julius Tower features modern interiors with a warm, neutral palette and a pop of golden yellow.

Refreshed in 2016, the 948-room **Augustus Tower** features a classic Caesars theme with a contemporary design, including cool grey tones accented by royal blue and champagne gold. These luxurious rooms are conveniently located on the southern end of the resort near the Garden of the Gods Pool Oasis and hotel lobby. The Augustus Tower initially opened in August 2005, with an additional valet entrance for VIP guests.

Caesars Palace and Nobu Hospitality developed the world's first **Nobu Hotel**, a boutique hotel within the larger destination resort that opened in February 2013. The innovative concept integrates an exclusive hotel tower with the first Nobu Restaurant & Lounge on the Las Vegas Strip. The 182-room Nobu Hotel offers 18 suites and a rooftop villa with stylish interiors showcasing natural materials fused with Nobu's signature Japanese elegance. Nobu Hotel guests enjoy a bevy of perks, including private check-in, Natura Bisse luxury bath amenities and access to the exclusive in-room dining menu curated by Nobu's acclaimed culinary team.

On Jan. 2, 2012, Caesars Palace opened **Octavius Tower**, the resort's sixth hotel tower. The 23-story tower features 642 rooms, including 62 suites and six luxury villas. The Octavius Tower offers a luxurious boutique hotel experience within Caesars Palace, featuring stylish rooms with a neutral palette, starting at 550 square feet.

In 2010, Caesars Palace debuted three luxury villas in the **Augustus Tower**, with spacious floor plans spanning an average of 8,800 square feet. Each villa features imported marble floors; a private elevator; hand-distressed wood parquet and inlaid wood floors; hand-painted murals and ceiling designs; wood and stone archways and casings; a billiard room; a plush home entertainment theatre; whirlpool bathtubs in the master and guest baths; steam mist showers in all bathrooms; fully-integrated audio-visual systems with televisions in nearly every room and custom contemporary artwork. An outside private terrace includes a spa tub, fire pit, seating and dining area with a gas lantern and wall sconces. Villa guests may also enjoy the luxury of private butler and concierge services. The 900-room Augustus Tower opened in late 2005.

The 24-story **Forum Tower** features 452 guest rooms, 10 two-story suites that provided inspiration for the movies "Rain Man" and "The Hangover," 60 two-bay suites, 18 executive suites and two penthouses (9,500 and 12,500 square feet). Caesars Palace completed the \$83 million renovation of the Forum Tower in October 2008. The Forum Tower is located on the northern end of the resort near the Forum Food Hall, The Colosseum and The Forum Shops.

No two shows are the same – with varying band members and the occasional special guest, fans are promised a once-in-a-lifetime performance each night. Whether it be one fiddle player, percussion and background vocals, or the whole band, each song, as well as every performance, is a unique and shared experience night after night for Garth and his audience.

Jerry Seinfeld

The world-famous comedian, author, producer and director, Jerry Seinfeld, returns to The Colosseum at Caesars Palace for six shows in 2023 to perform his world-famous stand-up comedy.

Rod Stewart

Rod Stewart: The Hits. is a concert celebration featuring a set list of the rock and R&B favorites that have defined Stewart's unparalleled five-

decade-long career. The spectacular, state-of-the-art production is a culmination of Stewart's seminal hits like "Maggie May," "You Wear it Well," "Hot Legs," "You're in My Heart" and "Some Guys Have All the Luck" mixed with a few surprise rarities and sizzling covers. Rod Stewart: The Hits. gives audiences that intimate, only-in-Las Vegas concert experience – with no fan more than 140 feet from the magnificent stage.

RACE & SPORTSBOOK

Caesars Race & Sportsbook

The energy runs high at the Caesars Race & Sportsbook at Caesars Palace. Guests can follow the action on a custom-built, 143-inch HD LED display, coupled with state-of-the-art 4-Zone Directional Sound. The space offers 140 seats with an unparalleled view of every TV, plus the convenience of 13 betting windows.

NIGHTLIFE

OMNIA Nightclub at Caesars Palace

Designed by the internationally renowned Rockwell Group, OMNIA is a Tao Group Hospitality concept that spans 75,000 total square feet. The multi-level venue encompasses a seductive ultra-lounge, a high-energy main room and mezzanine, as well as a breathtaking rooftop garden, showcasing panoramic views of the Las Vegas Strip. Headling DJs include Steve Aoki, Martin Garrix, Alesso, ILLENIUM and more.

Alto Bar

Located near OMNIA Nightclub, Alto Bar is the largest bar at the resort and features several private booths equipped with personal televisions with audio. The bar space also offers eight high-definition TVs and 18 video poker machines. The drink menu includes classic cocktails with a modern twist, as well as a variety of bottled beers, draft beers and wines by the glass. For a premium nightlife experience, guests can enjoy bottle service as well.

Galleria Bar

Galleria Bar in the hotel lobby allows guests to enjoy a cocktail as they await check-in, offering 24 seats and 22 multi-game slot machines. With a modern take on a palatial Italian study, the bar features four life-size Venus sculptures and a backdrop of antique mirrors, cerused wood with antique gold accents and Italian inlaid wood murals. Guests can also enjoy vino by the glass from the Coravin® wine preservation system, including the red blend from Overture by Opus One, pinot noir from RAEN and cabernet sauvignon from Beaulieu Vineyard BV Rutherford Reserve. Open 24 hours a day, Galleria Bar is in the hotel lobby between the main entryway and the entrance to the outdoor Roman Plaza.

Lobby Bar

Open 24 hours a day, Lobby Bar features expansive lounge seating just steps away from the front desk reception area and the Palace Court high-limit tables. Gold accents and contemporary Roman art highlight Lobby Bar's sleek and stylish aesthetic.

Montecristo Cigar Bar

Montecristo Cigar Bar pairs notable cigar offerings with fine whiskeys, small bites and more, in a contemporary, organic 4,000-square-foot environment. Throughout the entire space is a state-of-the-art ventilation system, ensuring guests a comfortable and fresh visit. The 100-seat bar/lounge and gaming area offer visitors four distinct experiences to enjoy a smooth cigar and cocktail – The Signature Bar, The Library, The Courtyard and the private dining room. Montecristo features one of the largest humidors in the city, housing up to 1,000 cigars. Additionally, the 208-inch video wall and TV screens throughout make Montecristo a prime spot to watch the game.

Numb Bar & Frozen Cocktails

Numb Bar & Frozen Cocktails is conveniently located on the casino floor. The walk-up bar makes it quick and easy for guests to grab a drink while enjoying the action. Visitors can select from a variety of slushy drinks like the Strawberry Butterfly and Purple Haze or order their favorite spirits from the full-service bar.

Purple Zebra

Guests can soak in the upbeat ambiance at this patio bar, situated near the ABSINTHE show tent and enjoy a variety of frozen fruit cocktails amid the unparalleled people-watching on the Roman Plaza. Purple Zebra offers a multitude of flavors and spirits with extra shot additions available.

Stadia Bar

Stadia Bar offers a next-level sports viewing experience with lavish amenities, numerous large HD TVs, a menu overflowing with high-end and unique cocktail selections and more. Designed by Rockwell Group, the 120-seat, 2,186-square-foot sports hub features the excitement, drama and grandeur of being seated in a live sports arena. Guests can choose to be seated at the elevated bar or reserve one of the five VIP leather-wrapped domes, exclusively designed for Stadia Bar. Each dome creates the feeling of sitting within a vintage leather football helmet and gives guests an intimate viewing area with their own LED screen.

Vanderpump Cocktail Garden

Television star and restaurateur, Lisa Vanderpump, debuted her first Las Vegas venue, Vanderpump Cocktail Garden in 2019. Vanderpump Cocktail Garden offers exclusive cocktails and bites in a garden oasis setting. With design inspiration from Vanderpump, her husband Ken Todd and designer Nick Alain, the stunning space welcomes guests with an indoor patio featuring an al fresco-style garden with 16-foot olive trees and romantic lighting fixtures. The romance continues as the lounge inside elegantly fuses natural elements with industrial décor, including Lisa's signature feminine touch with contrasting masculine details. Vanderpump Cocktail Garden focuses on innovative craft cocktails as well as small bites, shareable plates and Instagram-worthy desserts. With plush seating throughout and a space that transports guests into a decadent destination, Vanderpump Cocktail Garden is perfect for a casual gathering or a big night out.

VISTA Cocktail Lounge

A great pre-show meeting spot, VISTA Cocktail Lounge offers an upscale cocktail experience with views of beautiful cityscapes on LED screens. Guests can enjoy a selection of specialty cocktails, beers and wines by the glass, as well as bottle service.

RESTAURANTS

Brasserie B by Bobby Flay (Coming Soon)

Following the tremendous success of Amalfi by Bobby Flay, the award-winning chef will introduce a new French concept at Caesars Palace. Brasserie B by Bobby Flay will offer delicious and distinct French-inspired dishes for brunch, lunch and dinner. The menu will be an intersection of French cuisine and Flay's creative touches. Guests can expect the unexpected, as Flay puts his signature twists on classic frites, unique raw bar selections, a variety of starters and entrees and decadent desserts. Designed by Olivia Jane Design & Interiors, Brasserie B features an L-shaped, 20-seat bar with weathered marble, fluted wood and zinc accents. The lounge flows into the main dining space, which includes a showstopping raw bar with a lit canopy that spills over the tables below. The intimate, 140-seat dining room features blown glass chandeliers, cane-backed cafe chairs and handmade subway tile.

Peter Luger Steak House (Coming Soon)

Legendary New York Steak House Peter Luger is coming to Caesars Palace in Las Vegas. This marks the first domestic expansion in more than 60 years for the restaurant, which opened its doors in 1887 and is commonly known as New York City's original steak house. Operating for more than 135 years, Peter Luger is New York's top-rated steak house and a favorite among locals and tourists alike. The iconic German beer-hall setting has become a world-famous choice for family gatherings, deal-making, and special occasion celebrations. With its notoriously gruff, bow-tied waitstaff, old-world charm, and on-site dry-aging of legendary USDA-Prime steaks, dining at Peter Luger has become a culinary rite of passage.

Amalfi by Bobby Flay

Inspired by Bobby Flay's extensive travels to Italy and the Amalfi Coast, Amalfi by Bobby Flay is the award-winning chef's first Italian restaurant concept. Amalfi transports guests to the Mediterranean with its enchanting blend of coastal ease and fresh, bright flavors. Flay's interest in Italian cuisine runs deep, with special admiration for its simplistic elegance and festive eating. Amalfi's menu features light antipasti, a large selection of rich pasta, whole fresh fish and a few traditional desserts with a twist. A focal point of Amalfi is a fish and seafood display, inspired by authentic Italian markets and staffed by a knowledgeable fishmonger, who is available to answer any guests' questions – from fish origination to its Las Vegas arrival and more.

Bacchanal Buffet

Bacchanal Buffet redefined the Las Vegas buffet experience when it opened in 2012. In May 2021, following more than a year of renovation, the award-winning buffet reopened showcasing a multimillion-dollar enhancement. Bacchanal's seafood, carving, American and Latin

kitchens, as well as the entrance and dining room received major upgrades and improvements. Bacchanal is one of the largest buffets in Las Vegas, spanning more than 25,000 square feet with 10 kitchens, nine chef-attended action stations and more than 250 dishes. Due to popular demand, Bacchanal Buffet offers brunch service five days a week and a special Crab Brunch in the early afternoon, in addition to dinner daily. Bacchanal offers reservations through OpenTable.

Beijing Noodle No. 9

Guests will be intrigued the moment they arrive at Beijing Noodle No. 9 as they walk through the dramatic entrance surrounded by enormous fish tanks. The restaurant features authentic Northern Chinese cuisine, which includes mouth-watering selections of soup, dim sum, hand-pulled noodle and rice dishes, as well as chef specialty creations.

Brioche by Guy Savoy

Guests can indulge in famed Chef Guy Savoy's world-renowned cuisine at his sweet and savory brioche shop, conveniently located near the Main Valet entrance. Brioche by Guy Savoy offers delectable tastes of this flaky French pastry that can be studded with mushrooms, parmesan and nuts, or sweet candied fruit and pralines. These pastries can be paired with a selection from the shop's finest freshly brewed coffees. For an expanded dining experience, guests may visit Restaurant Guy Savoy on the second floor of Augustus Tower.

Dominique Ansel Las Vegas

James Beard Award-winning pastry chef Dominique Ansel brings his creative culinary talents to Caesars Palace with Dominique Ansel Las Vegas. Chef Dominique is responsible for creating some of the most famous pastries in the world, including the Cronut[®], which was named one of TIME Magazine's "25 Best Inventions of 2013." Signature items include the Cronut[®] with flavors that change each month and never repeat, DKA (Dominique's Kouign Amann), Frozen S'mores and more. Dominique Ansel Las Vegas is also home to the first and only Cookie Shot Vending Machine, which dispenses Cookie Shots 24 hours a day.

Forum Food Hall

Since opening in December 2014, the highly acclaimed Forum Food Hall has quickly become a fan favorite. Not only has it brought fresh, quality dining options to guests in a casual quick-service format, but the food hall has also brought numerous firsts to the Las Vegas Strip. Dining options include Guy Fieri's Chicken Guy!, Bobby's Burgers by Bobby Flay, DiFara Pizza, The Halal Guys and Starbucks.

Gordon Ramsay HELL'S KITCHEN

The first-of-its-kind, Gordon Ramsay HELL'S KITCHEN is a high-energy dining destination inspired by FOX's globally popular "Hell's Kitchen" television show. With design features that are a nod to the red and blue teams featured on the show, the dynamic and bustling kitchen is the centerpiece of this unique eatery. Situated on one of the busiest corners in Las Vegas and at the center of The Strip, HELL'S KITCHEN seats nearly 300 guests and features indoor and Strip-adjacent dining for lunch and dinner. Guests can enjoy many cast and chef recipes and

dishes featured on the show, including many of Chef Ramsay's signature dishes.

Gordon Ramsay Pub & Grill

Celebrity Chef Gordon Ramsay created his version of an authentic English pub experience with Gordon Ramsay Pub & Grill. The grill section of the restaurant features a relaxed and friendly setting with dishes, including Fish & Chips and the famous Sticky Toffee Pudding for dessert. The pub features elevated British pub food in a comfortable and lively setting showing sporting events from across the world on state-of-the-art entertainment systems.

MR CHOW

Celebrity hot spot MR CHOW opened its long-awaited Las Vegas location of the chic and legendary restaurant brand inside Caesars Palace in December 2015. With locations in Beverly Hills, New York, Miami and London, the well-known restaurant conceptualized and perfected refined Beijing cuisine dining with European-style service. The menu features beloved dishes such as the Chicken Satay, Green Prawns, hand-pulled MR CHOW Noodles and the famed Beijing Duck.

Nobu Restaurant & Lounge

Chef Nobu Matsuhisa introduced one of the largest Nobu restaurants in the world, located in the heart of Caesars Palace. Adjacent to the world's first Nobu Hotel, the restaurant boasts a sushi bar, private dining rooms, a lounge and bar area, and teppanyaki tables. Signature dishes include Black Cod with Miso, Yellowtail Jalapeño and Rock Shrimp Tempura with Creamy Spicy Sauce.

Pronto by Giada

Following the success of GIADA at The Cromwell, Pronto by Giada at Caesars Palace offers guests Giada De Laurentiis' signature Italian fare with California influences but in a fast, casual format. Pronto is warm and inviting offering something for every guest. Coffee fans will delight in the pouring of Counter Culture coffee, featuring traditional fresh brews and nitro options. Those wanting to enjoy the chic space and socialize can leisurely enjoy wine from a menu of wines by the glass or a cocktail at the full-service bar.

Restaurant Guy Savoy

One of France's most revered and award-winning chefs, Guy Savoy has brought his legacy to Caesars Palace and created one of the city's most unique and unforgettable dining experiences. Accolades for Restaurant Guy Savoy include the Forbes Travel Five Star Award, AAA Five Diamond award and a Michelin Star. The menu includes many classic Guy Savoy dishes, including the "Colors of Caviar," Seared Foie Gras and the signature Artichoke and Black Truffle Soup. In addition to the exquisite menu offerings in the intimate dining room overlooking the Eiffel Tower replica, Restaurant Guy Savoy is the only restaurant in the world to offer the KRUG table where guests can experience an up-close view of the chefs at work.

Stanton Social Prime

Stanton Social Prime, the new dining concept from Tao Group Hospitality and Chef Chris Santos, draws inspiration from the original restaurant on New York's Lower East Side and the Las Vegas Strip, with a modern nod to Art Deco style and dramatic showmanship. Guests enter the 200-seat space through the velvet curtain to the main dining room featuring bold colors of ruby red, sapphire blue and gold with rich textures and patterns found in extravagant costume design. The restaurant also offers a 10-seat bar and two private dining rooms. Stanton Social Prime's steaks are a highlight of the menu, seasoned with house dry rub, rested in a bath of Beurre de Baratte, finished with pink Himalayan salt and served with roasted black garlic. Additionally, Stanton Social Prime brings Chef Santos' signature sharable dishes to the center-Strip resort, including the Famous French Onion Soup Dumplings and Pierogies.

SHOPPING

The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace offers 675,000 square feet of impressive retail, dining and entertainment options. Featuring 160 specialty shops and restaurants, The Forum Shops is home to some of the most celebrated retailers including many that can be found nowhere else in Las Vegas. In addition to the distinctive mix of retailers and restaurants, The Forum Shops boasts an iconic spiral escalator and the must-see, free animatronic attraction – The Atlantis Show and Aquarium. Consistently named among the top-performing shopping centers worldwide, The Forum Shops is recognized for its unique combination of top retail, dining, entertainment, excellent location and exciting thematic ambiance.

Appian Way Shops at Caesars Palace is a 25,500-square-foot shopping center positioned in a winding, centralized hallway between Numb Bar & Frozen Cocktails and Gordon Ramsay Pub & Grill. It offers the finest apparel, gifts, art and jewelry.

Qua Baths & Spa

Named one of Spas of America's Top 100 Spas, Qua Baths & Spa at Caesars Palace is a tranquil oasis inspired by ancient Roman traditions of relaxation. The stylish 50,000-square-foot spa taps into the natural healing powers of water and features highly trained Artisans that perform a full range of traditional spa services and signature treatments to soothe the body and stimulate the senses. Qua opened in 2006 and offers 51 treatment rooms including three deluxe couples' studios and seven facial rooms.

Juno Garden

This elegant venue boasts tropical landscaping, palm trees, lush foliage and classic Roman architecture, making it the perfect spot for an unforgettable outdoor wedding. The Juno Garden seats up to 128 guests.

Venus Garden

Surrounded by tropical palm trees, a blooming floral landscape and Roman architecture, the Venus Garden is a beautiful selection seating up to 115 guests. The garden features a Roman-style temple, a relaxing

koi fishpond, a fountain and a unique stone-tiled aisle.

Classico Chapel

The largest indoor hotel chapel on the Las Vegas Strip, the Classico Chapel is adorned in a classical theme of beige, light blue and cream, with seating up to 196 guests. Chandeliers, stained glass windows and magnificent floral arrangements add to the chapel's undeniable charm and grace.
