

# JetBlue's Holiday Live From T5 Concert to Feature a Performance From British Band Rixton on December 18

VH1 Save the Music Foundation Grant Recipient Schools to Open for the Chart-topping Platinum Band at This Special Pop-Up Concert at JFK

NEW YORK, NY -- (Marketwired) -- 12/12/14 -- JetBlue Airways (NASDAQ: JBLU), New York's Hometown Airline™, will host an exclusive live performance from chart-topping British sensations -- [Rixton](#) -- on Thursday, December 18, 2014 at 4 p.m. ET at its world-class Terminal 5 (T5) at New York's John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK). Rixton will spread holiday cheer for JetBlue customers and crewmembers as well as some of their biggest fans.

Rixton will perform their chart-topping singles at this special concert. Following on the success of their debut platinum hit single and U.K. No. 1 "**Me And My Broken Heart**" and their U.K. Top 10 follow-up "**Wait On Me**," Rixton has announced their next single will be "**Hotel Ceiling**," which they will perform at T5. The track is the third single from the Manchester band's eagerly anticipated full-length debut album **Let The Road**, which will be available in the U.S. and around the world on March 3, 2015 via School Boy/Giant Little Man/Mad Love/Interscope Records.

JetBlue's Live From T5 concerts are held post-security at T5 at JFK and are exclusively for ticketed customers and contest winners. The airline and Rixton have also invited a VH1 Save The Music group of 35 New York City public school students to open for the band creating a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. Participating schools include Bell Academy (Queens, NY), Marine Park Intermediary School (Brooklyn, NY) and MS 129, Academy for Independent Learning and Leadership (Bronx, NY).

For this special holiday concert, JetBlue has also partnered with Interscope Records and Rixton for a contest to provide tickets to some of the group's most dedicated fans. Beginning today, fans can enter via the group's website and social media channels for a chance to win passes (winner plus a guest) to this exclusive, intimate concert as well as a private meet and greet with the band trio.

"We are excited to welcome Rixton to perform via this unique platform. Several artists on the cusp of international acclaim and breakout success in the U.S. have graced JetBlue's Live From T5 stage. Rixton's debut *Me And My Broken Heart* EP, featuring their multi-platinum hit single of the same title, cracked the Top 10 and Top 40 radio charts, climbed to No. 1 on the UK Singles chart and ranks one of the most Shazam-ed new tracks in the U.S., while the official video has racked up more than 40 million views on YouTube/VEVO. Rixton has delivered killer performances on [Late Night With Seth Meyers](#), [The Voice](#), [Ellen](#), [So You Think You Can Dance](#), [The TODAY Show](#), [Jimmy Kimmel Live!](#) and more, in addition to being featured as an MTV 2014 "Artist To Watch" and a VEVO LIFT artist. The band released their follow up track "Wait On Me" and just announced their new single "Hotel Ceiling" will be released in January. Rixton will set out on a US tour supporting Ariana Grande in February prior to the release of their debut album **Let The Road** on March 3 via School Boy/Giant Little Man/Mad Love/Interscope Records. Hailing from Manchester, Rixton are **Jake Roche**, (vocals/rhythm guitar), **Danny Wilkin** (bass/keys), **Charley Bagnall** (lead guitar), and **Lewi Morgan** (drums).
