Cambridge Display Technology acquired Next Sierra and Mr. Page continued his development work there through 2008. Since that time, Mr. Page has served as an independent consultant to a number of high-tech organizations.

Mr. Page holds a Master's degree in Computer Science and a Bachelor's degree in Physics and Mathematics from San Jose State University.
