


# Snapshot of American in New York City (LGA)

## 06 History

1929

The Gala Amusement Park is transformed into the private 105-acre Glenn H. Curtiss Airport.

1937

NY City takes over and purchases an additional 357 acres of waterfront. It is renamed the New York City Municipal Airport.

1939

American is LaGuardia Airport's first tenant. The first Admirals Club and airport lounge in the world opens at LGA.

1940

Pan Am flying boats make the first-ever transatlantic and round-the-world flight from LGA's Marine Air Terminal.

1953

The airport is renamed LaGuardia Airport for former New York City mayor Fiorello La Guardia

American carried more than **8.5 million** passengers through LGA in 2016.



## 09 American is Good for New York

- American employs approximately 9,000 colleagues in the New York metropolitan area and nearly 120,000 companywide.
- American operates 400 daily departures from 12 cities in both New York and New Jersey with access to more than 70 destinations around the world.
- As the world's largest airline, American operates an average of 6,700 flights per day to nearly 350 destinations in more than 50 countries. American is the founding member of **oneworld**®, whose members serve more than 1,000 destinations with about 14,250 daily flights to more than 150 countries.
