It's a plane. It's a food truck. It's awesome!

On July 9, Tomorrow's Aeronautical Museum (TAM) debuted the first-ever Douglas DC-3 aircraft to be converted into a gourmet food truck during a ceremony in South Los Angeles. The plane, a fixed-wing propeller driven aircraft, helped revolutionize air transportation in the 1930s and 1940s and is most recognized for its military contributions during World War II. The iconic DC-3's fuselage is now taking on a new mission: supporting aspiring young aviators from Compton, California.
