We're connecting the City of Brotherly Love like no one else can. **PHL is now American's largest trans-Atlantic gateway** thanks to new service to destinations like Budapest and Prague. Next year, we'll also add North America's only U.S. service to Dubrovnik and Bologna.

Fly Eagles Fly. We can't take full credit for their big victory, but since **recommitting as the official airline of the Philadelphia Eagles in 2015**, we've handed out 1,000s of rally towels and flown in fans from across the country with our Fan Fly-In promo.

**We've invested more than \$200 million in PHL facilities**, including our 34,000-square-foot Terminal F renovation and expansion project, and a joint project to bring eight new dining destinations, 1,000 iPads and 15 tech-driven gate lounges to Terminal B.

In 2015, **American opened a state-of-the-art, 25,000-square-foot cargo cold storage facility at PHL**, tripling the airport's capacity for transporting pharmaceutical items to, from and through the Northeast corridor and strengthening the regional economy.

American has more than 8,700 PHL-based team members, **which means we've added more than 1,000 to our ranks since 2013**. Our presence contributes more than \$12 billion to the city's economy annually and we are proud to be PHL's largest carrier.
