More than 280 honorees and their guests attended the special event, which included live entertainment from Motown legend Martha Reeves. More than 400 team members met the impressive threshold.

We traveled the world and instilled that love of travel in our daughters. My youngest is currently in Europe, and I will get the honor of flying her back from Munich next month."
