“By delivering the cargo consumers use on daily basis, we continue to connect people and connect the world through our cargo operation.”

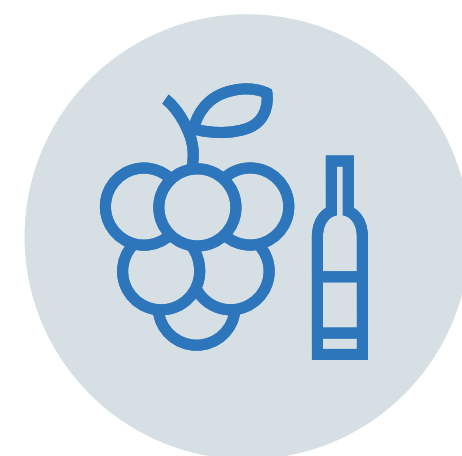


American carries

of cargo annually**

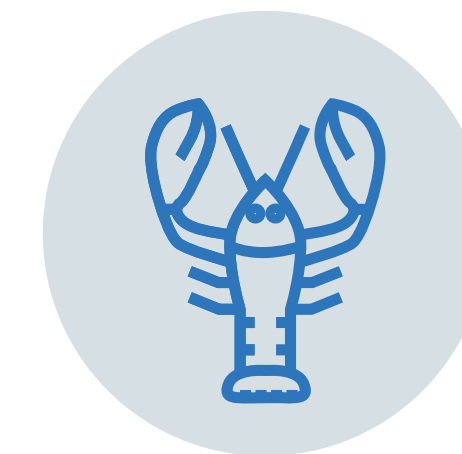
