American Airlines names Tony Richmond Executive Vice President, Corporate Affairs, and Chief Legal Officer

Richmond as Executive Vice President, Corporate Affairs, and Chief Legal Officer, effective May 5. Richmond will join American from global law firm Latham & Watkins, where he has served as a partner in the Corporate Department since 1996. For more than three decades, Richmond has advised a range of clients, from startups to Fortune 500 companies, on novel legal issues and complex, landmark transactions. He has significant expertise in finance and securities matters involving both public and private companies.

A major force behind the development of the firm's corporate practice and a key contributor to its strategic

direction, Richmond has served in numerous key leadership roles at Latham & Watkins. He chaired the Audit Committee for over a decade, and currently serves as chair of the firm's Strategic Initiatives Committee, of which he has been a member since 2015. Richmond previously served as co-chair of the firm's Retail & Consumer Products Industry Group.

Richmond began his career at Deloitte as a certified public accountant (inactive status). He earned both a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Juris Doctor from the University of California, Berkeley.
