FORT WORTH, Texas — As American prepares to hit the century mark, the airline has reached a milestone, receiving its 1,000th mainline aircraft. The premium Boeing 787-9 aircraft with American's recently launched Flagship Suite® seats arrived at Dallas Fort Worth International Airport (DFW) on Aug. 29.
