looking to make the trip even more special, American will operate flights from New York (JFK) to LAS using its Airbus A321T aircraft, featuring 10 lie-flat Flagship© First and 20 lie-flat Flagship© Business seats. American will also operate the A321T on select flights to Los Angeles (LAX), offering one-stop lie-flat premium connections to transcontinental destinations, including JFK and Boston (BOS).

Customers purchasing an eligible itinerary will be able to enjoy an elevated preflight experience. On the ground at JFK, customers ticketed in Flagship© First will be able to access the exclusive Chelsea Lounge™ experience, featuring a stunning circular champagne bar with a la carte dining amid a relaxed environment. Flagship© Business customers will receive access to the Greenwich Lounge™, offering chef-inspired meals and a premium wine table in addition to the Bridge Bar and Tasting Room experiences.

From Miami (MIA) and Philadelphia (PHL), American will operate one daily round-trip service using Boeing 787 aircraft for inbound travel on Feb. 8 and Feb. 9 and outbound travel on Feb. 12. On peak days, American will offer more than 150 lie-flat seats to and from LAS.
